

DESIGN A NATIONAL BOOK TOKEN

TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. Entries must be sent in before Friday 12 April 2019 only. Entries received after this date will not be accepted.
2. Entries must be returned to: World Book Day Design a Book Token Competition, Book Tokens Ltd, 6 Bell Yard, London WC2A 2JR.
3. All entries MUST have printed on the reverse of the entry: age and name of school child; school name (if applicable – please make it clear if the child is home-schooled), address and telephone number.
4. All entries must be signed by a parent/guardian or teacher (please print name also).
5. Prizes will be awarded as follows: 1st Prize in each age range – £250/€270** National Book Tokens for the school (please note home-schooled children will not be eligible to win this element of the prize), £100/€110** National Book Tokens for the school child and £100/€110** National Book Tokens for the teacher (or parent/guardian if home-schooled). Runners-up Prize in each age range – £150/€170** National Book Tokens for the school (please note home-schooled children will not be eligible to win this element of the prize), £50/€55** National Book Tokens for the school child and £50/€55** National Book Tokens for the teacher (or parent/guardian if home-schooled).
6. The organisers (World Book Day Ltd and Book Tokens Ltd) will not be responsible for the loss of or damage to any entries and entries will not be returned.
7. Entries must be no larger than A4 and drawn in portrait format, according to the template shown.
8. All entrants should be resident in the UK or Republic of Ireland and in full-time education.
9. The judges' decision is final and, regrettably, no correspondence can be entered into.
10. No cash alternatives to the prizes will be offered.
11. Copyright on all entries submitted will remain with the individual creators, except in the case of the three age-range winners and the overall winner, in which case, Book Tokens Ltd will require the assignment of the copyright. The fee for this assignment is inclusive in the overall prize.
12. The organisers reserve the exclusive right to inform the media of all results and details of the competition, including the names and details of the winning schools.
13. By entering the competition, entrants will be deemed to have accepted the rules and conditions of the competition.
14. Employees of Book Tokens Ltd and their agencies and members of their immediate family are not eligible to enter.
15. Proof of postage will not be taken as proof of entry.

* Subject to the winning design being suitable for use as a National Book Token, all or part of the design will be published.

** National Book Token prizes will be supplied in Sterling (if the winner is located in the UK) or Euros (if the winner is located in the Republic of Ireland).
