April reader questions: *High-Rise Mystery* by Sharna Jackson

1. The opening of the book throws you straight into the action – how did this make you feel as you read it?
2. Nik is the narrator of the story – how do you think Norva's telling would be different? What would she say about Nik?
3. Nik and Norva use different approaches when they are looking at the case – who are you most like?
4. Was there anything that you would have done if you were solving the case that Nik and Norva didn't?
5. Were there any characters that surprised you?
6. The book's setting as Nik and Norva's home means they know that they will know the killer – what does that do to you as a reader?
7. The book uses dialogue as a way to move the story along – what impact does this have on you as a reader?
8. Did you guess the murderer before the end? What were the clues that gave it away for you?
9. Have you read any other mystery books? Were there any similarities?
