



# PAIRS GAME

## Rules (2-6 players)

- Shuffle the cards and lay them face down on a table.
- The youngest player goes first. Play then proceeds clockwise)
- On each turn, a player turns over two cards (one at a time). If the pictures on the cards are the same, that player wins that pair and has another go. If the pictures on the cards are not the same the player turns both cards face down again and it becomes the next player's turn.
- The game continues until all the pairs have been found. The player with the most pairs is the winner.

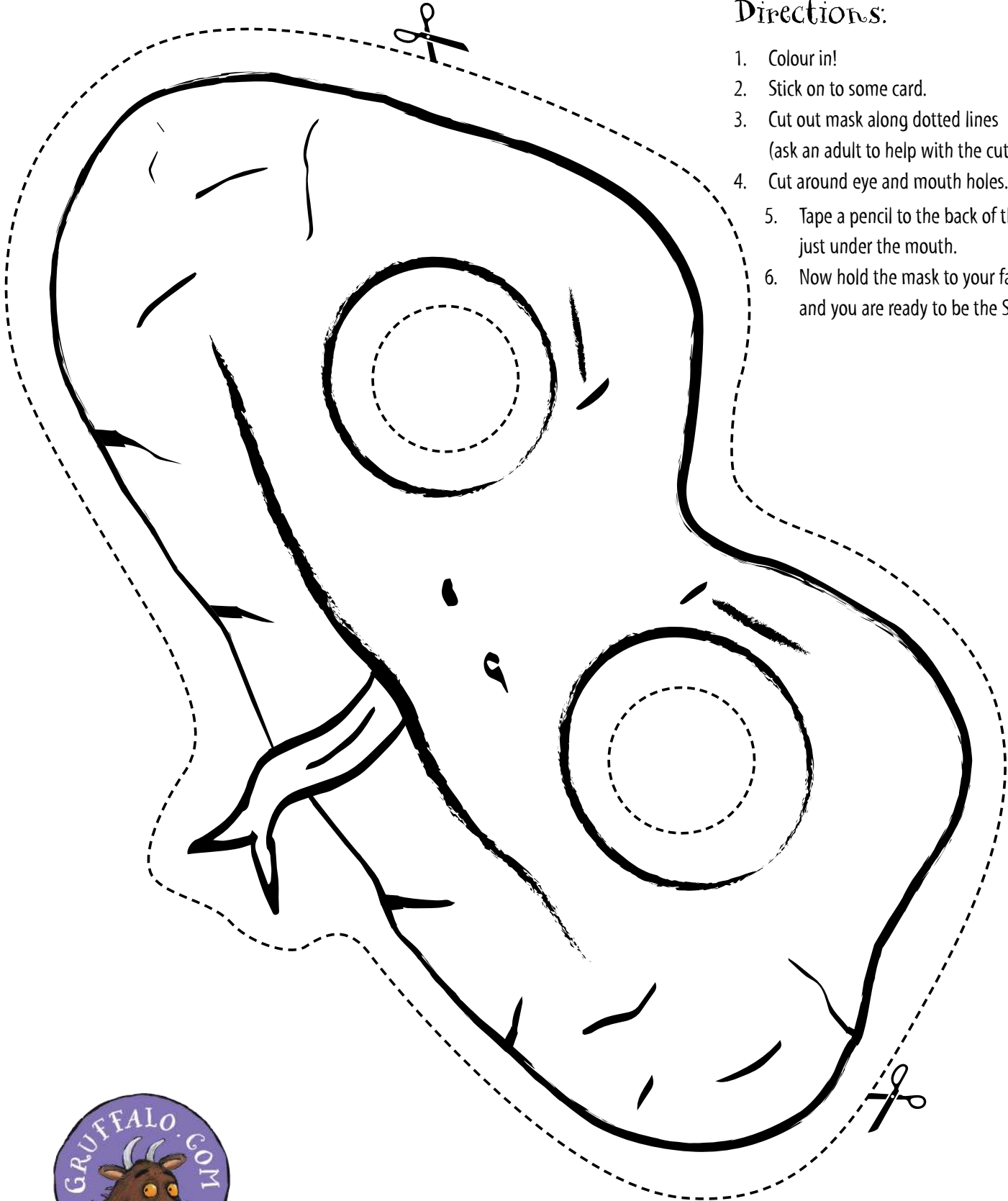
# A Snake mask to colour and make.

6. Now hold the mask to your face and you are ready to be the Snake!



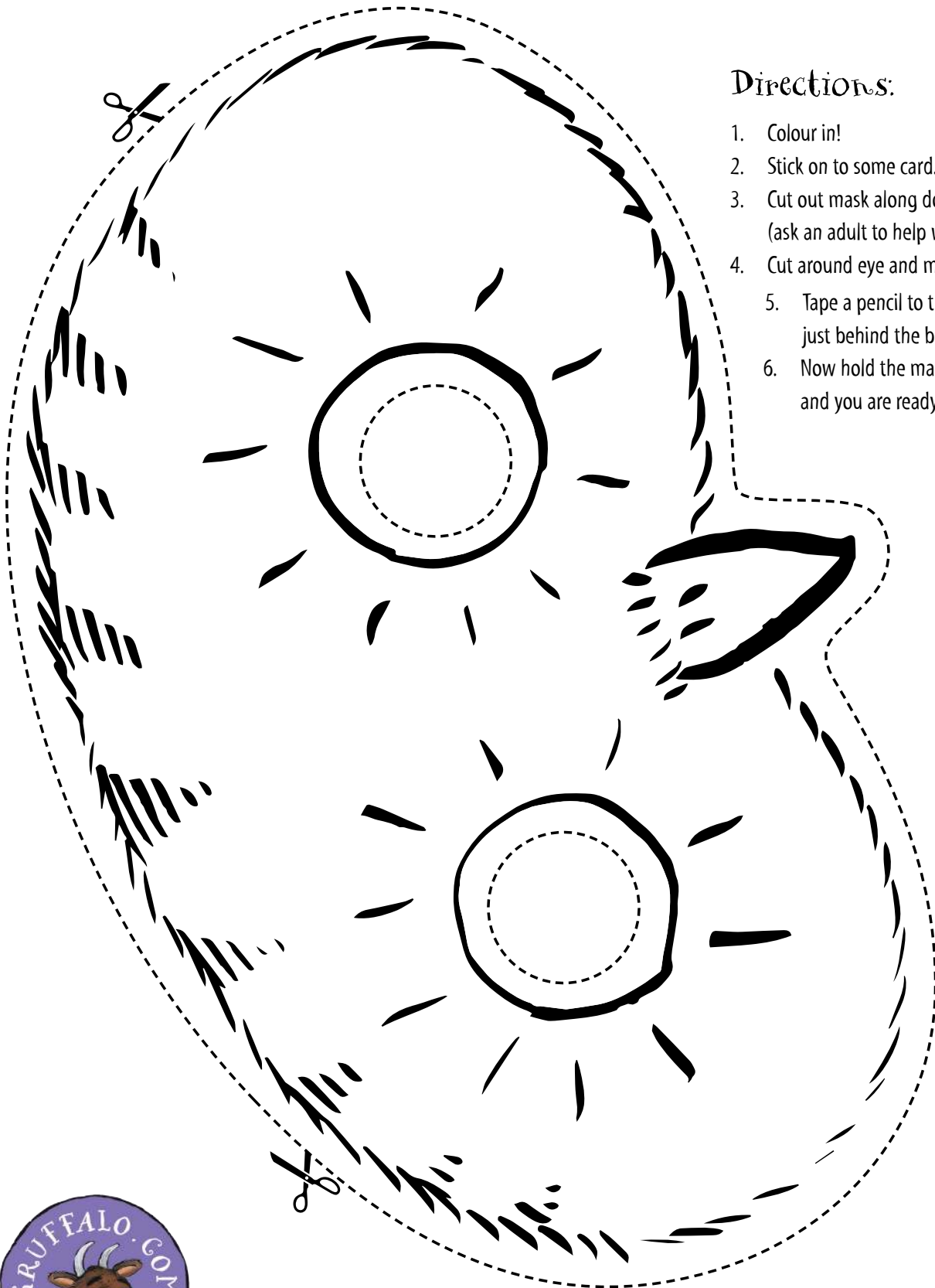
# An Owl mask to colour and make.

You will need:

Coloured pencils • Scissors • Sellotape and glue • A piece of thin white card

## Directions:

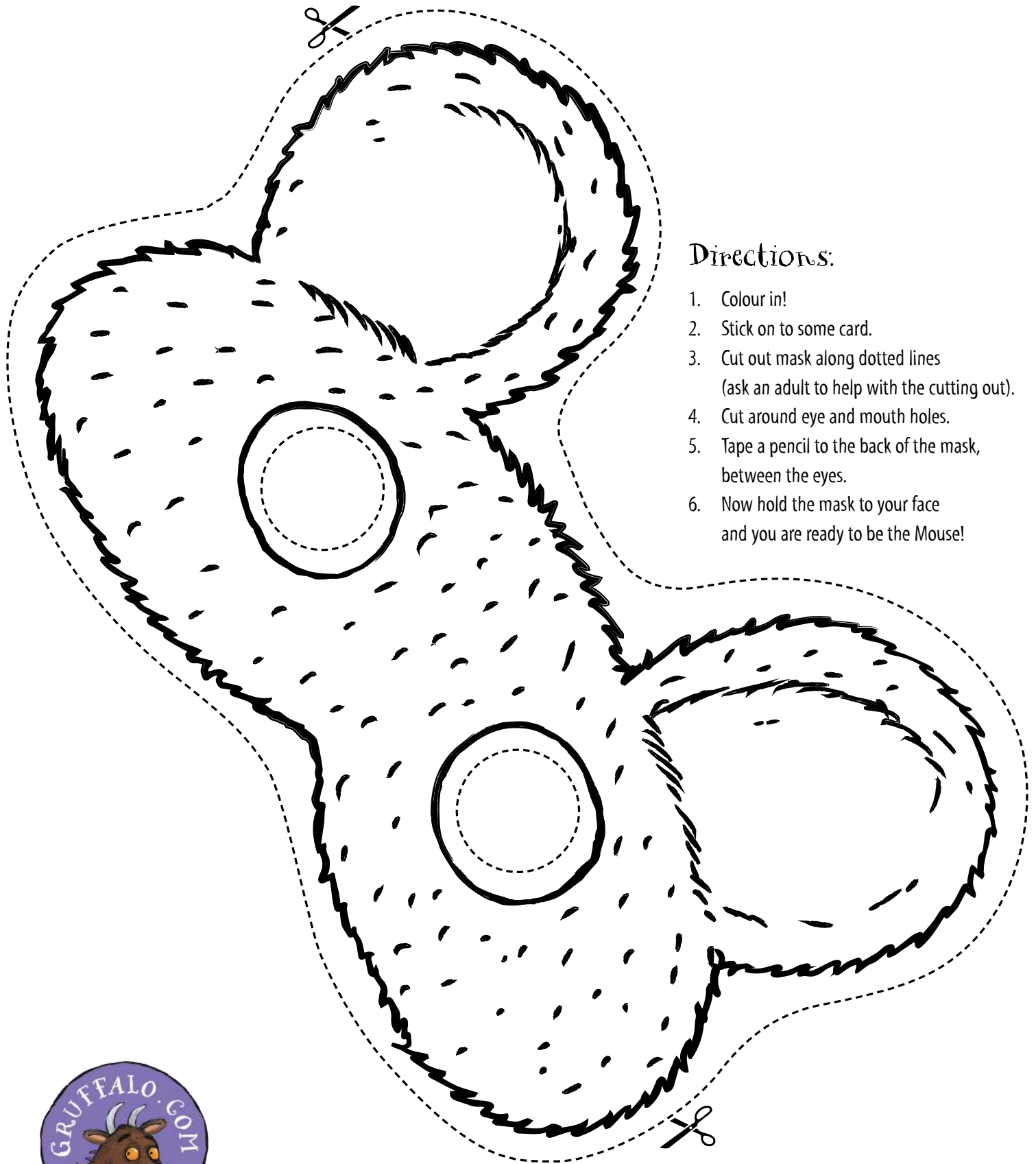
1. Colour in!

3. Cut out mask along dotted lines (ask an adult to help with the cutting out).
4. Cut around eye and mouth holes.
5. Tape a pencil to the back of the mask, just behind the beak.
6. Now hold the mask to your face and you are ready to be the Owl!



# A Mouse mask to colour and make.

You will need:

Coloured pencils • Scissors • Sellotape and glue • A piece of thin white card



## Directions:

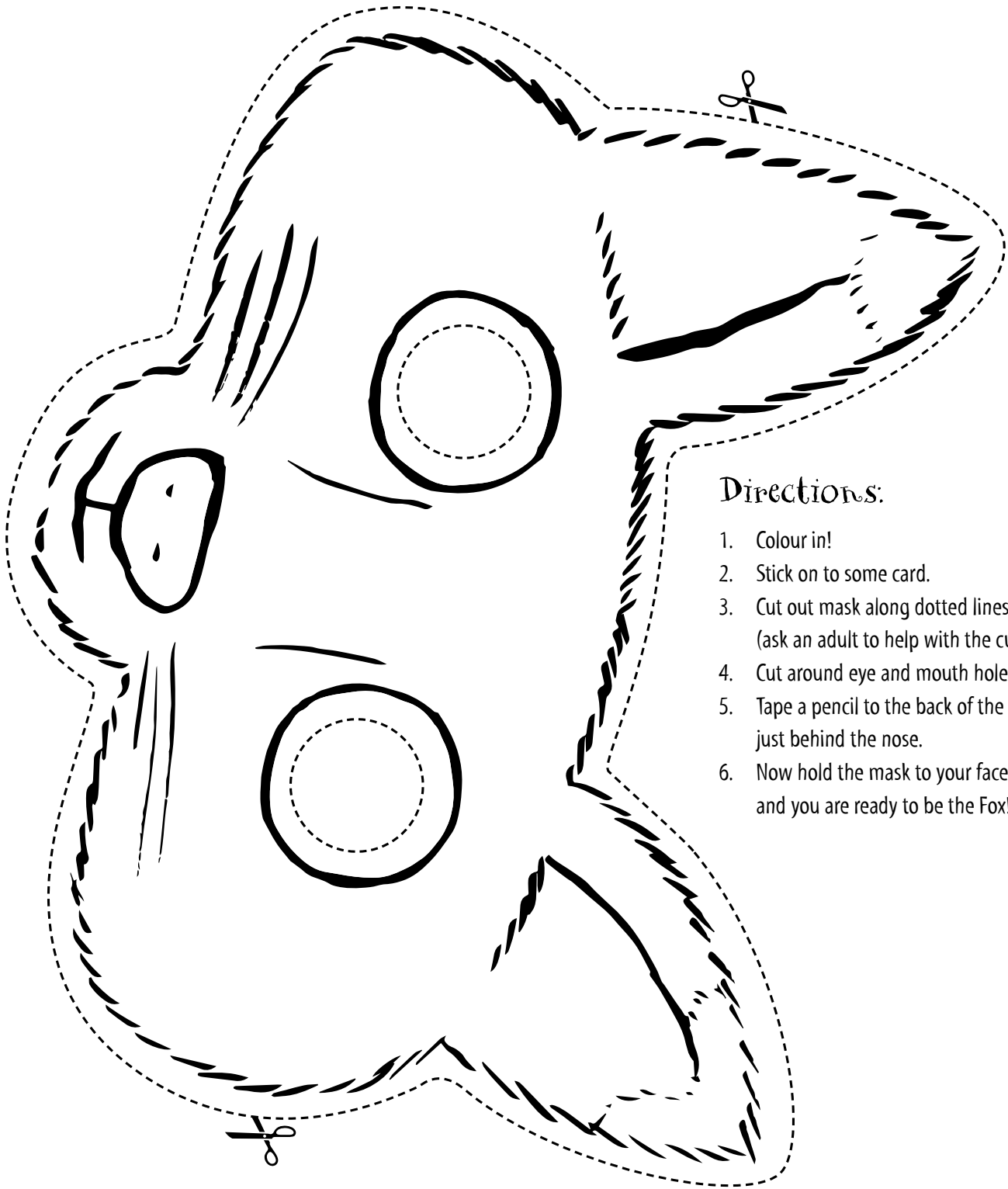
1. Colour in!

3. Cut out mask along dotted lines (ask an adult to help with the cutting out).
4. Cut around eye and mouth holes.
5. Tape a pencil to the back of the mask, between the eyes.
6. Now hold the mask to your face and you are ready to be the Mouse!



# A FOX mask to colour and make.

You will need:

Coloured pencils • Scissors • Sellotape and glue • A piece of thin white card



## Directions:

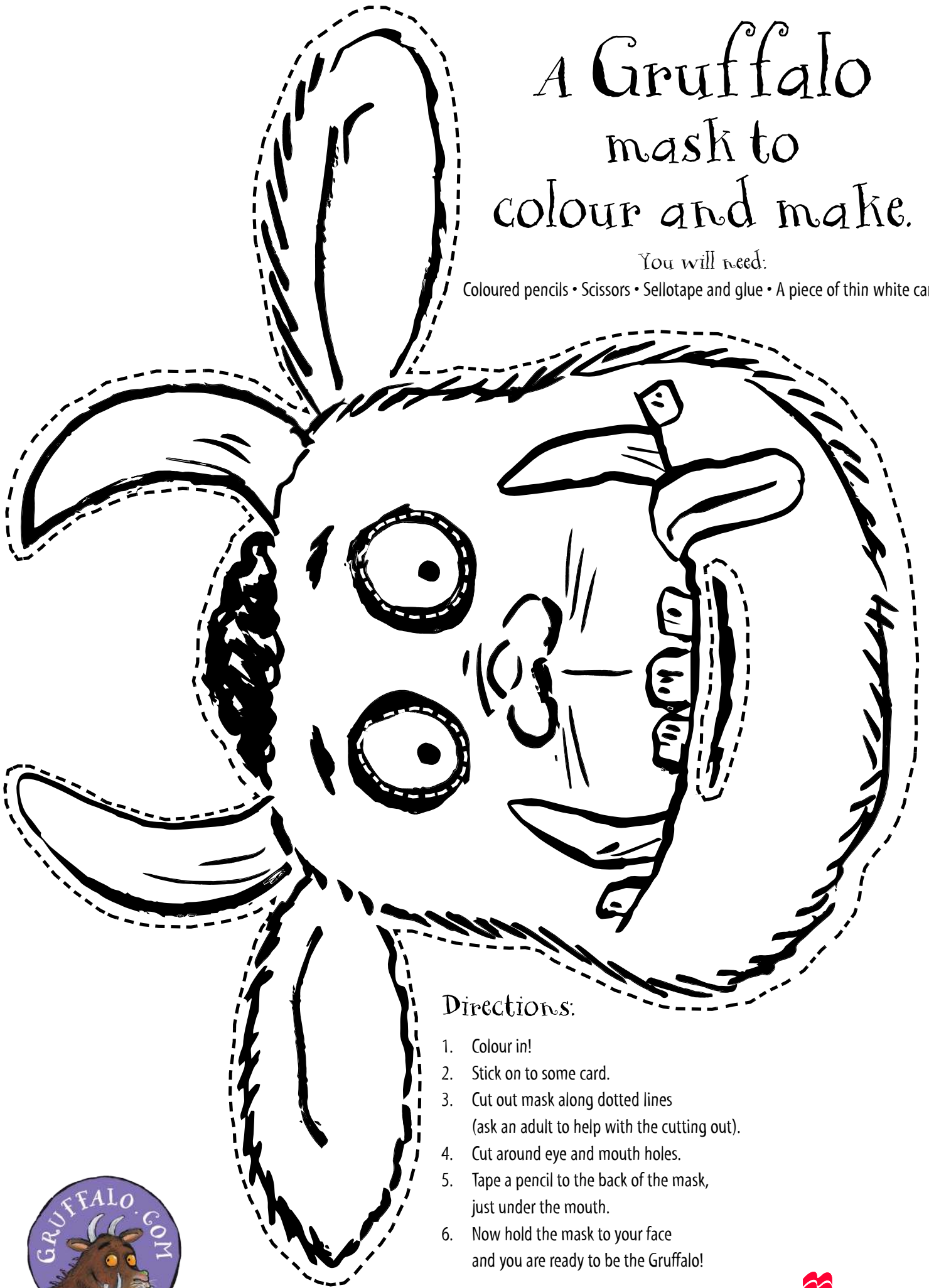
1. Colour in!

3. Cut out mask along dotted lines (ask an adult to help with the cutting out).
4. Cut around eye and mouth holes.
5. Tape a pencil to the back of the mask, just behind the nose.
6. Now hold the mask to your face and you are ready to be the Fox!



# A Gruffalo mask to colour and make.

Coloured pencils • Scissors • Sellotape and glue • A piece of thin white card

3. Cut out mask along dotted lines  
(ask an adult to help with the cutting out).
4. Cut around eye and mouth holes.
5. Tape a pencil to the back of the mask,  
just under the mouth.
6. Now hold the mask to your face  
and you are ready to be the Gruffalo!
