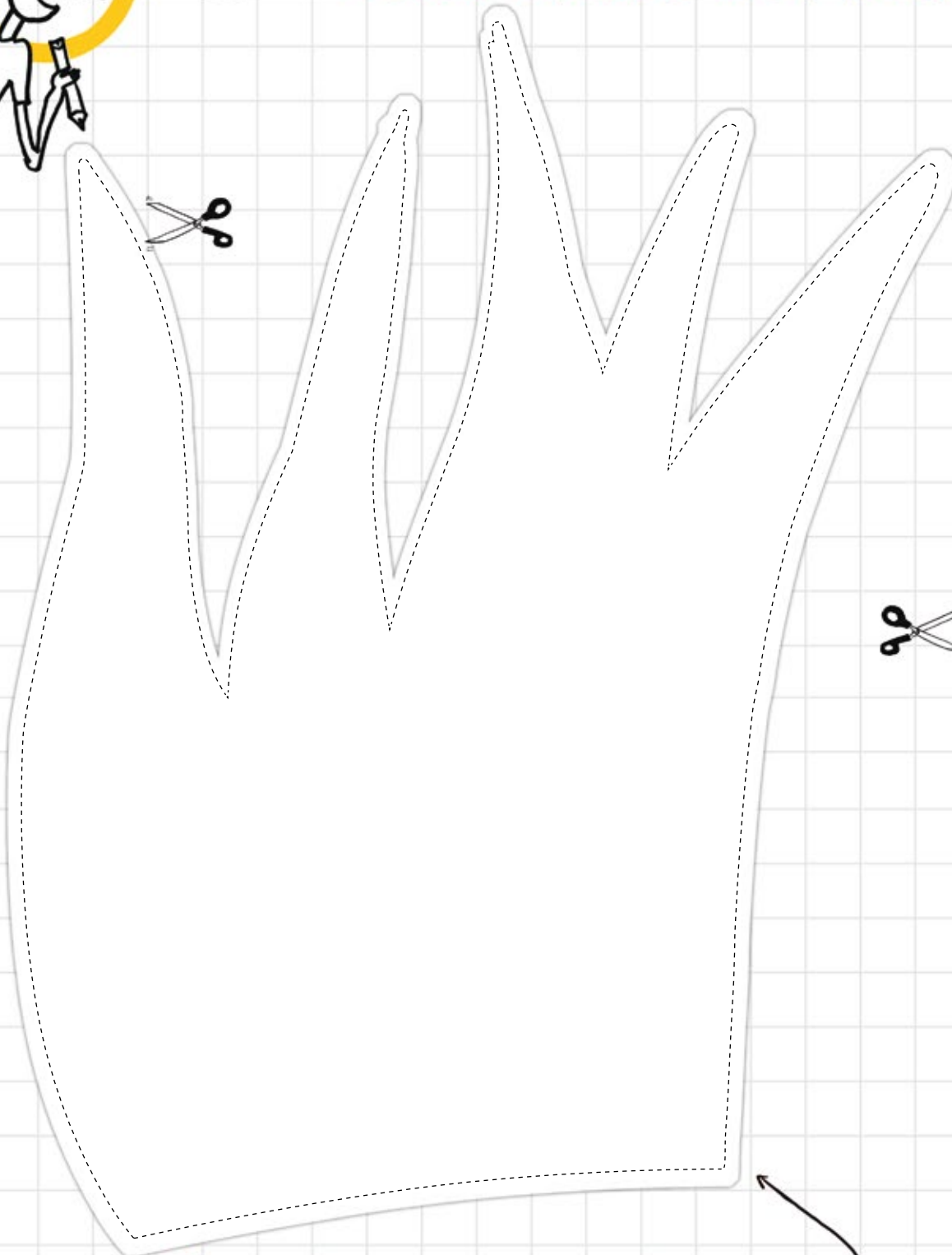




# MAKE YOUR OWN LOKI-HAIR HEADBAND



1 Print out this piece of paper. (If you don't have a printer, you can follow the steps on the next page.)

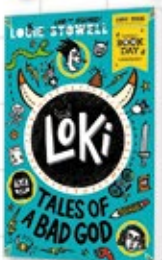
2 Using a black colouring pencil or pen, fill in Loki's hair.

3 Cut out the hair and the two strips of paper.

4 Glue or tape one end of each paper strip to the back of the hair, near the bottom.

5 With the hair at the front, wrap the strips around the back of your head and tape the ends together. (You may need someone to help you.)

# NO-PRINT LOKI-HAIR HEADBAND

You don't need a printer to look as awesome and cool as Loki, but you will need:

EITHER a plain piece of paper and a black colouring pencil (or pen)  
OR a black piece of paper (or thin card)

A pencil

Scissors

Glue or sticky tape

Ooh, drawing?  
I'm very good at that. (As I am at most things.)



1. Cut two strips from the long side of your piece of paper. Each strip should be about as wide as two of your fingers. Keep the strips for step 5!
2. On the remaining piece of paper, draw a shape for the hair. To look like Loki, your hair should have **FIVE** spikes.
3. If you used plain paper, then you need to fill in the hair. (If you used black paper or card, you can skip this step.)
4. Cut out the hair.
5. Glue or tape one end of each strip onto the back of the hair, near the bottom.
6. With the hair at the front, wrap the strips around the back of your head and tape the ends together. (You may need someone to help you.)

Loki is the Norse god of mischief, famous for his tricks. He is also a shapeshifter. If YOU were a god like Loki, or perhaps one of the more impressive ones, like Thor, or Heimdall, or Odin or...

Ahem!



If YOU were a god, what would you be the god of, and what would be your special power? Can you think of any other famous gods from stories or legends?

None of them are as handsome and clever as me...



Aren't they? Maybe you could draw them with hair that's even more "awesome" and "cool" than Loki's?

Impossible!
