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

Creating the readers of the future

Reading for pleasure makes a vital difference to children's life chances, but is at its lowest level since 2005.

That's why booksellers and World Book Day® work together to share the joy of reading and books with children and families. Last year, over 4,000 booksellers hosted World Book Day events. Your expertise helps children and young people discover reading for pleasure.

Nearly 1 million children in the UK don't have a book of their own¹. With your help, World Book Day offers every child and young person the opportunity to exchange their £1/€1.50 token for a free book.

1 in 5 pupils receiving Free School Meals (20.7%) said that the book they 'bought' with their World Book Day £1/€1.50 token was the first book they had had of their own.²

Booksellers play a special role in bringing the joy of reading to children and young people.

Entering a bookshop, supermarket or high street retailer, proudly waving their £1/€1.50 token, children are empowered to choose their World Book Day book for free.

This year, we're putting children's voices at the heart of World Book Day. Our research with children has highlighted that they are told that reading is important but our actions as adults are making them feel that reading is hard work and not something they can enjoy in their spare time. This year, we're asking everyone to support our **Read Your Way** message to show children that they can have a choice in what and how they read and to give them the opportunity to have fun with reading.



OUR MISSION: To promote reading for pleasure, offering every child and young person the opportunity to have a book of their own.


World Book Day improves children's life chances,




World Book Day logo & assets

Booksellers who are running events and celebrations for World Book Day should use this 'Celebrating with' logo.

When using the 'Celebrating with' logo, you don't need to send your assets to us for approval.









DO

Refer to the charity World Book Day, our mission and activities. It's important that people understand that it is more than just a cultural or promotional moment.

Make sure you use our 6 principles of reading for pleasure (see page 3) as guidance for your activities, artwork, materials and events.

Ensure the eyes of the World Book Day logo are pointing to the most important thing on the page and the logo is 5mm away from the edge of the page on all sides.

Direct children & families to the World Book Day £1/€1.50 tokens and how children can swap their token for a £1/€1.50 book for free, wherever possible.

Include the $^{\circ}$ symbol where the words World Book Day are first mentioned.

Feature imagery of books and reading wherever possible.

Make sure any events that you are running using the World Book Day branding are free to attend (unless you are fundraising on behalf of our charity).

Include Vivian Truong's copyright logo from the asset pack when using her artwork. If space is limited, please add a text credit instead: World Book Day illustrations © Vivian Truong 2024.



DON'T

Use the World Book Day brand and assets for commercial gain or exploitation. Talk to us about co-promotions or partnerships.

Raise money for other charities using our branding. Any fundraising using our trademark or visual assets must be in aid of World Book Day.

PLEASE REMEMBER

World Book Day promises every child the opportunity to choose and own a book of their own. Nearly 1m children in the UK do not have a book of their own (Source: National Literacy Trust).

If you are accepting the £1/€1.50 token please ensure the £1/€1.50 books are also available so that all children can participate. You may only use the World Book Day logo, branding and assets if you are supporting the **free token exchange**.





What they did:

- Zoom book-choosing session with a roving bookshop camera for schools.
- Monthly, half-termly and termly book subscriptions - books come wrapped with a clue on the outside.
- World Book Day school visits.
- Storytelling and supported choosing sessions for schools.

Wonderland Bookshop, Retford

What they did:

- Shared wish lists so parents could come and refresh school book stock.
- School book club visits.
- Book Fairs taken to schools with an accompanying assembly. You can find an assembly guide on our Celebrate World Book Day page.

The Little Rippon Bookshop

What they did:

- Sent each local school a copy of the World Book Day books for assembly.
- Visited schools during World Book Day week with a full range of books, including the £1 titles, so every child could choose a book with their token.
- Ran a paper plate character competition displayed in the window.
- Built a crazy, noisy book dispensing machine, which resulted in a queue of children down the street.



Running a World Book Day® event guide

What is World Book Day?

World Book Day is a celebration of reading for pleasure run by the charity World Book Day. Their mission is to promote reading for pleasure, offering every child and young person the opportunity to have a book of their own.

Reading for pleasure is important because it's proven that people who choose to read in their spare time do better at school and work and feel happier too.

Running an event for World Book Day is a great way to show children and young people how fun reading can be and to share why you think it's important.

Read Your Way

This year World Book Day wants to encourage children to **Read Your Way**, a campaign aimed at supporting children and young people to discover reading on their own terms, as a hobby.



Start by introducing yourself

And why not include:

- Your favourite childhood book or book you're currently enjoying with your own children.
- Your favourite book/what you're reading at the moment.
- Where and when you like to read.
- Don't feel you have to stick to printed books or fiction.
 Sharing that you enjoy audiobooks in the car or only read at the weekends supports the READ YOUR WAY message.

Pick some activities from the suggestions below

All these activities support the 6 principles we've identified that encourage children to read for pleasure.



Share a story – either use a favourite of yours or share an extract from one or two of our World Book Day £1/€1.50 books. You can access extracts from the books by using the look inside feature on the £1/€1.50 book pages on our **website**.

Having books at home and school

If it is possible, **include children swapping their £1/€1.50 book tokens** and make this part of the event.

Having a choice in what to read

Make sure you **celebrate what the children want to read**. Include free reading time to ensure that the whole event isn't structured around a single book.

Do they need help choosing from this year's £1/ \in 1.50 books? All our books have activities to introduce them **here**.

Finding time to read

Invite the group to share their favourite reading time with you.

You could ask what they like to read in different scenarios:

- At bedtime.
- After a busy day.
- On holiday.
- While they're eating a snack.



Having trusted help to find a book

Encourage the group to **recommend their favourite books**. To make this more fun, you could ask everyone to come dressed as their favourite book! You'll find lots of ideas including alternatives to dressing up **here**.

Making reading FUN!

Try one of our games to encourage children to share their favourite books:

NEVER HAVE I EVER....

Children take turns trying to find books that haven't been written - for example:

Never have I ever read a book with a vampire as the main character...

Never have I ever read a book set here...

Award points for categories that no-one can think of a book recommendation for.

CHARADES

Children act out a book title. You could ask them to drop their favourite book title into a bowl and then each person pulls out a title to enact.



Thank everyone for coming

Remind the children they can use their token in exchange for any of the £1/€1.50 titles and wish them a Happy World Book Day.



Token barcodes

On this page you'll find all the barcodes for the tokens we have distributed via schools, early years settings and our partners. Larger retailers should check that they are set up on their systems. For independent bookshops these have been set up centrally with Batch if you use this system. Using barcodes just means we can track which tokens are redeemed; however, it is also fine just to accept tokens from children, count them up and submit the total on the evaluation form you'll receive in April.





In pairs spin the spinner and take turns to recommend books






