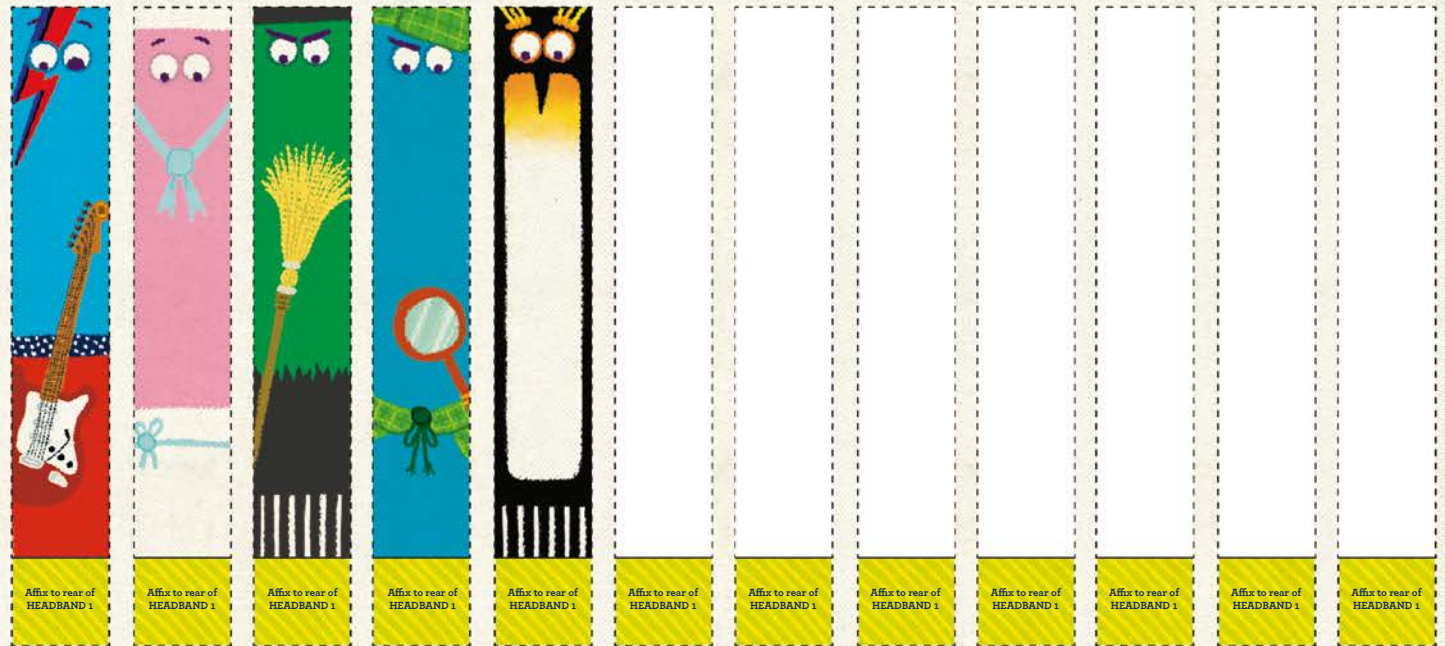

INSTRUCTIONS

- Carefully cut out **HEADBAND 1** and **HEADBAND 2**
 - With some glue or sticky tape, join the two rectangles, pairing **TABS A** and **D** and **TABS B** and **C** to form a circular band of paper. Make sure you get the size right by placing them around the head before sticking them together.
 - Choose which bookmarks (right) you'd like to decorate your crown with and carefully cut them out. There are some that have been left blank for you to create your own designs.
 - Stick them, using glue or tape, to the rear of **HEADBAND 1**, facing forward, as shown on the illustrations below.
 - Start reading.
- TOP TIP:** To make your crown stronger, stick everything onto some card before you start assembling.
