


World Book Day gives every child in the UK & Ireland the opportunity to have a book of their very own (sometimes their first).



# How World Book day works . . .


- Every year we distribute over **30 million £1 book tokens** for children & young people to exchange for one of these **brilliant books for FREE** or £1 off another book (worth £2.99 or more).
- We encourage EVERYONE to celebrate books and reading for pleasure whether that's at school or at home.
- EVERY child in the UK & Ireland can pick one of these brilliant books to keep.

- This year, families can use the £1 token when they collect essential shopping OR hold on to it to use later.
- Find World Book Day's £1 books in major supermarkets and bookshop chains. High street bookshops may be open for click and collect.
- Children can use the 'Look Insides' on our website to choose their £1 book.
- Bookshops are offering new ways to make the £1 books available, even in lockdown.
- Booksellers will honour the tokens beyond the 28 March (while stocks last) and many are planning to welcome families to World Book Day events later in the spring.








