

# DRESS UP AS... THE WORST WITCH

## YOU WILL NEED

- ✓ Black paper: one piece of A1 or two pieces of A2 size
- ✓ Scissors
- ✓ Pencil
- ✓ Double-sided tape
- ✓ Stapler
- ✓ Heavy duty black tape (parcel tape or gaffer tape will also work)
- ✓ Hole punch
- ✓ Black elastic
- ✓ Downloadable hat cone template
- ✓ Downloadable hat base template



## TO MAKE THE WITCH'S HAT

1. To make the cone of the hat, print out the **hat cone template** twice, cut out the cone pieces and tape them together to use as one whole template. Place it on top of the black paper, draw around the outside and cut it out.

2. Roll the black paper into a cone and use double-sided tape to fix it together along one side. Use a stapler for extra reinforcement.

3. Use a hole punch to make two holes—one on either side of the cone, then attach the elastic to make a chin strap.





4. To make the hat brim, print out the **hat brim template** four times. Cut out the pieces and tape them together to make a big circle with a hole in the middle. Place this on to the black card. Draw and cut around it, making sure you remove the hole in the centre.

5. Place the hat brim over the top of the cone. Slide it down to the bottom and use lots of black tape to fix it into place.



6. For a little extra flourish, push a small triangular piece of black paper through the hole at the top of the hat, bend to one side and tape it in place! Finish by wrapping an old tie around the hat.

## OUTFIT TIPS

- School pinafore or an old black dress
- Grey or white school shirt
- Make a broomstick from a cardboard tube and tie some twigs round the end with a pipecleaner.

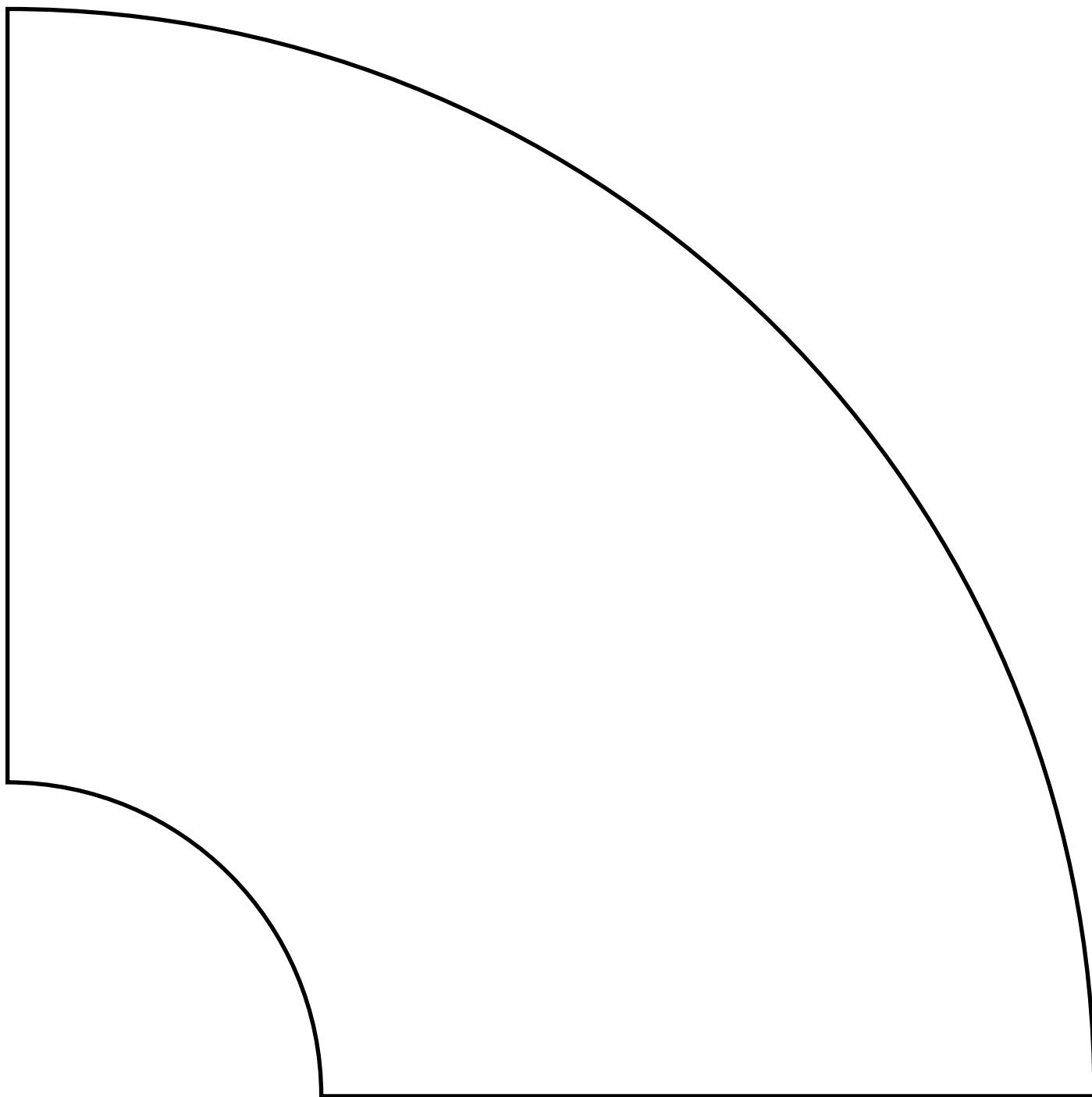

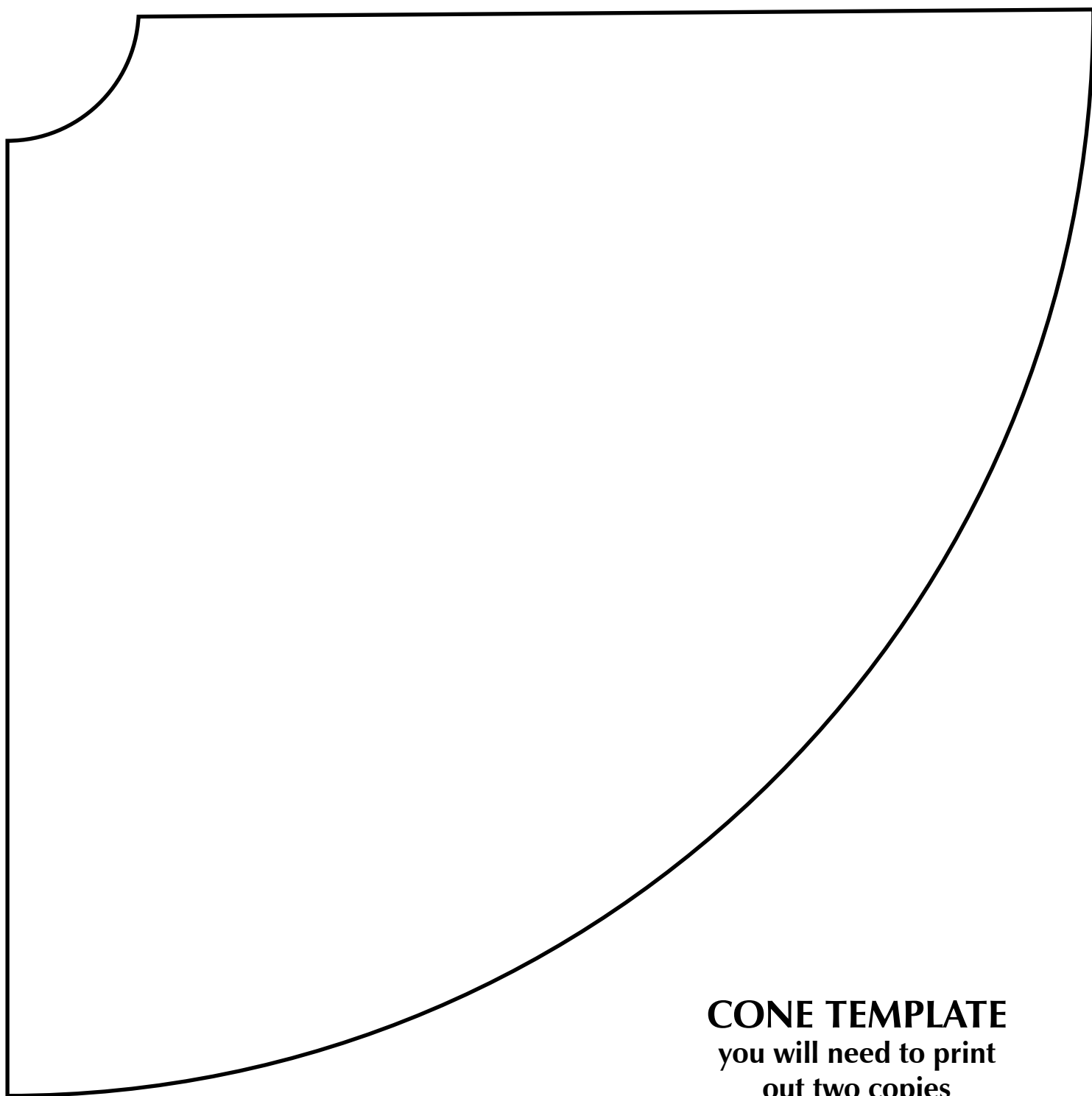
## Hat Brim Template
