- 1 A big World Book Day welcome**
At drop off ask the parents what their child's favourite book is at the moment – you could record these on tags as they arrive and either attach to the books themselves or to pictures of the children on a display.

Give out the **£1 / €1.50 book token** to every child and [explain how to redeem the token](#).
- 3 Start the day with a story**
Share a picture book or short story to get the day started!
