**CONVERSATION STARTER** Ask yourself: "What do I want to learn about the world today?" What's the one thing, big or small, that you'd really like to know more about?

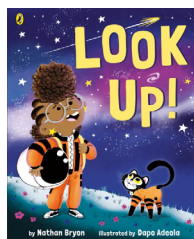
#### GAME: LOOK UP! PLAYERS 1+.

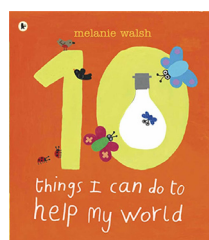
#### AN ACTIVITY TO TRY
