- Where would the bee like to get them from?

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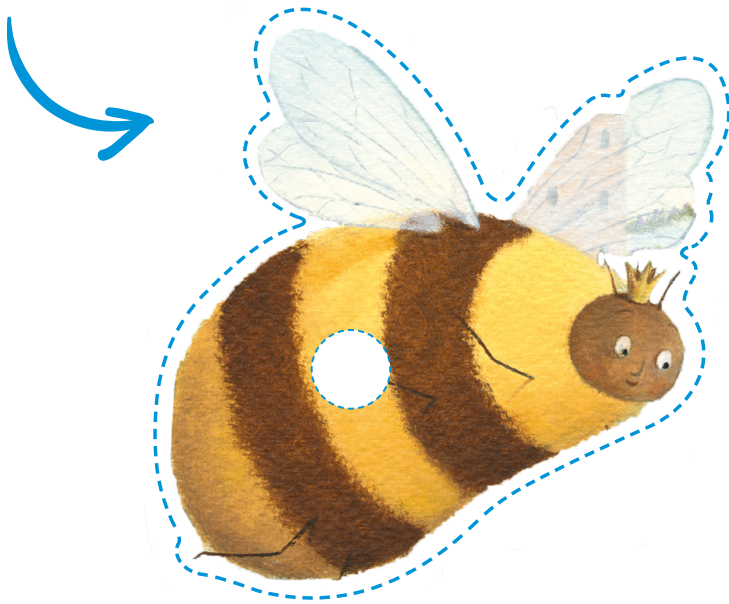
Bee hunt

- **No shelter:** Try making a hotel - find out more [here](#).



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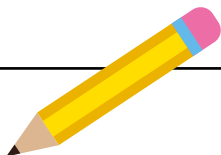
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Draw a map of your walk
