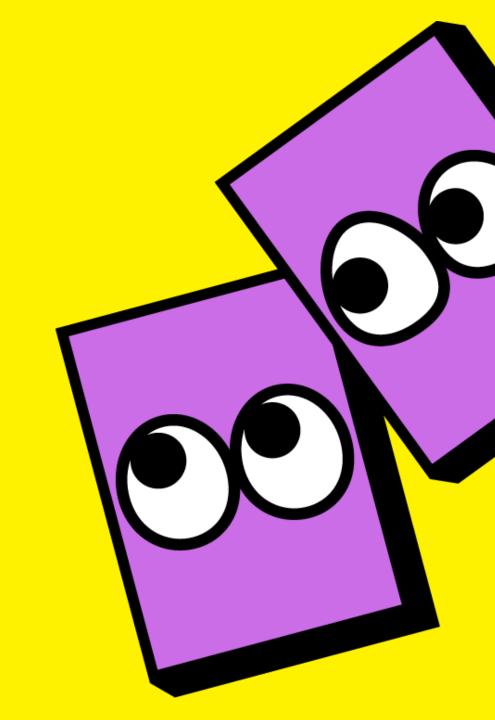
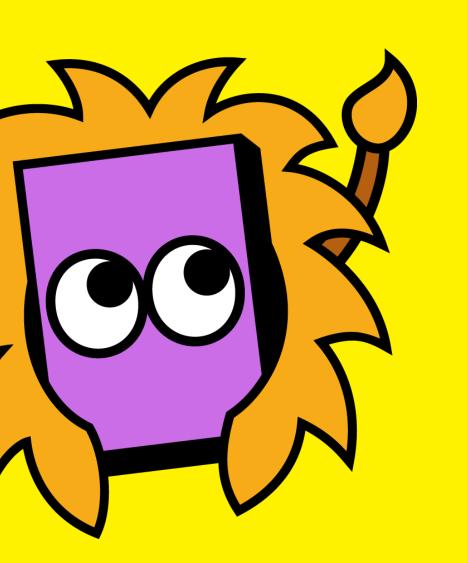

It's all about reading for fun

We know that when children choose to read more it makes them:

Better at reading

Feel happier

More successful

Our Big Six principles that encourage children to read for fun:

- Being read to regularly
- Having books at home and school
- Finding time to read

- Having a choice in what to read
- Having trusted help to find a book
- Seeing reading as fun!

As a result of World Book Day, children...

- Find reading more fun 38.6%
- Made more time to read 35.3%
- Have more choice in what to read 36.7%
- Talk more with family / friends 30%
- Read with parent / carer 24.3%
- Find new books to read 37.0%
- 1 in 4 (FSM) say the £1 book is the first book of their own



Children's reading for pleasure seems to be in crisis

Reading for pleasure matters

It's the **single biggest indicator** that a child will
grow up to enjoy a happier
and more successful life –
more than their family
circumstances, their parents'
educational backgrounds or
their income.

Go All In For World Book Day

- World Book Day will be bigger and better than ever during the National Year of Reading 2026
- The National Year of Reading is a nationwide campaign to get more people reading, by bringing reading to where culture is.
- Reading is a powerful plug-in to the things you already love a great way to go deeper into your existing passions. Put simply: 'If you're into it, read into it.'



How to use World Book Day in your library

Our messaging focuses on changing attitudes and behaviours, based on what children say would encourage them to read.

- let go of pressure and expectations
- give children a choice and a chance to enjoy reading.



- Celebrate choice:
 - reading in all forms is valid (audio, comics, books...)
- Relevance and reflection:
 hobbies and passions, reading and...
- Reading for fun and family life: reading to children.

12 February	£1/€1.50 book token redemption period starts
	Bookshops welcome children in with their tokens to choose their £1/€1.50 books for free.
	Events start happening from this point (Feb half term is a key moment!)
5 March	World Book Day
15 March	Book token redemption ends

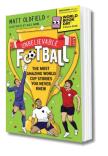


















World Book Day celebration ideas
